

Draft Reply to the Lok Sabha Q. No. 5908 dated 02.05.2013 Reg. 'Review of working of NGOs' by Shri Badri Ram Jakhar, Hon'ble M.P.

QUESTIONS

- a) whether the Government has reviewed working of Non-Governmental Organisation's (NGO's) working for Rural Development;
- b) if so, the details thereof;
- c) the details of the shortcomings if any, found in the working of NGOs;
- d) the remedial measures taken by the Government in this regard; so far,
- e) whether the Government has recently started a new grading system for categorization of these NGOs; and
- f) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWERS

- a) Review, per se, of the working of NGOs involved with rural development activities is beyond the scope of CAPART; however, CAPART does have a system of monitoring of the projects sanctioned to the NGOs under its various schemes.
- b) Details of three tier monitoring system for review of the project implemented by the NGOs are enclosed at Annexure-A ([English](#) / [Hindi](#)).
- c) No shortcoming has been found against the projects sanctioned during the last three years.
