

**Draft Reply to the Lok Sabha Q. Notice Diary No. 9069 dated 21.03.2013 Reg.
'Review of Working of NGOs' by Shri Badri Ram Jakhar, Hon'ble M.P.**

QUESTIONS

- a) whether the Government has reviewed working of Non-Governmental Organisation (NGOs) involved with rural development schemes;
- b) if so, the details along with the outcome thereof;
- c) whether any irregularities have been found in their working;
- d) the corrective measures taken in this regard; and
- e) whether the Government has recently introduced any new grading system for classification of NGOs?

ANSWERS

- a) Review, per se, of the working of NGOs involved with rural development activities is beyond the scope of CAPART; however, CAPART does have a system of monitoring of the projects sanctioned to the NGOs under its various schemes.
- b) Details of three tier monitoring system for review of the project implemented by the NGOs are enclosed at Annexure-A ([English](#) / [Hindi](#)).
- c) No complaint has been received against the projects sanctioned during the last three years.
